### "NOTHGIED"

WE give a hearty welcome this afternoon to our visitors from Wealdstone, Middlesex, who are members of the Isthmian League. This is Wealdstone's first visit to the North-East and we hope for a good day, a good crowd, and a good game.

The present Wealdstone Club was formed in 1899-1900, but it is known there were clubs operating before this time under the names of Wealdstone Mission, The Oaks, and a Gunsmith's Factory works team.

Wealdstone can claim the honour of being the first Amateur club to play at Wembley, in June, 1942, in the final of the Middlesex Senior Red Cross Cup.

It is interesting to note that on a number of occasions matches at Wealdstone have been televised, and the club tours include one to Southern Ireland. The record gate at Wealdstone is 13,504 in a replay fourth round of the Amateur Cup.

We all heard with regret the motoring accident to our groundsman, Nelson Webb, but are glad to know it was not serious. As usual we hope he has our ground in first-class order today.

Our club continue to receive letters from all over the world asking for badges, the latest being from South Africa.
