#### Saracens crash out of Europe

## Magnificent seven for Harrow Borough

HARROW BOROUGH thrashed Horsham 7-1 to record their biggest win of the season on Tuesday night.

Borough inflicted Horsham's heaviest home defeat for more than 16 years in a stunning performance. The victory extended their unbeaten run in the Ryman Premier to ten games and they have netted 22 goals in their last six outings.

Howell said: "As a football fan first and foremost, some of the football we are playing at the moment is absolutely brilliant. To see the development of the team and the players from the summer to now is absolutely brilliant.

Boro extended their lead after 27 minutes with a brilliant finish from Daniel McGonigle and Baptiste added his second after rounding the goalkeeper.

Horsham were reduced to ten men just before half time, with Michael Hector dismissed, and Boro punished them with the fifth goal when Kenta Nakashima finished smartly.

Baptiste completed his hat-trick late on with a close-range finish and Troy Hewitt capped a fine display with the final goal of a remarkable evening.
