Wealdstone Reserves—the only side to defeat Hendon this season—gained their third league point from their Middlesex neighbours on Tuesday evening, drawing 1-1 at Hendon.

The "Stones" plan of playing defensive football to contain Hendon's powerful side, and going all out for victory late in the game almost came off.

Inside-left Joe Smith was detailed to act as a second centre-half with wing halves Goldsby and Dilworth tackling Hendon's deep lying wingers. This operated so well that Hendon's attack was almost snuffed out in the first half.

Just on one occasion the "Stones" defence was caught square and Swain just managed to steer the ball past the advancing keeper Smith; this was after 35 minutes.

The "Stones" had forced four corners in the first five minutes and with only four forwards were relying on quick breakaways and individual ability.

Wealdstone played the same line up in the second half and Dick Smith in goal had few shots getting through to him. It wasn't attractive, but the desired result was achieved, and Hendon's dangerous forward line was kept under control.

With twenty minutes to go, right-half Goldsby moved up to centre-forward and Joe Smith took over at right-half, making a conventional line up with five forwards.

The "Stones" were pressing strongly now and seven minutes from time, Connell scored with a twenty yard drive to equalise and just after, the ball was in the Hendon net again. This was disallowed by the referee because of a pushing infringement.

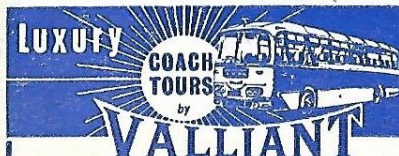
