WE DESERVED BETTER AFTER A GREAT GAME

THE elusive win which we really need to halt our recent disappointing run continues to elude us, and we dropped three important points at Telford on Saturday. But do not be misled by the scoreline. It was, in fact, a magnificent match, worth every penny of the admission charge, and was the sort of game which leaves a lot of very satisfied customers. Most of Telford's Directors felt it was the best match involving their side so far this season.

We are, of course, plagued by injuries at the moment, and just when we were counting our blessings at having 'Polly' Perkins back after so many months, he is now laid low with a recurrence of a very old back injury – a legacy of his early days in the game with Chelsea. With just the run of the ball we could have been two up in the first 10 minutes and we were most unlucky when Robin Wainwright rattled the Telford bar with a header. As it was Mark Graves put us ahead before Telford equalised direct from a free-kick before the interval.

Wealdstone's hopes received a big boost early in the second half when Wainwright planted a brilliant header wide of the goalkeeper and we were well in the ascendancy. But gradually Telford became more dangerous on the break, equalised, and then went two ahead. Needless to say, through putting everything into attack in the closing stages we lived dangerously in defence, which soaked up a lot of pressure.

All of a sudden, we're getting a few bad breaks, and although the football's still there, the results are proving hard to come by.

Incidentally, a big Lower Mead welcome to 22-year-old Kevin Baddeley, who manager Brian Hall has now signed from Swindon. Kevin has made 120 Football League appearances for Swindon, and began his professional career as an apprentice with Bristol City, before beginning a three year stint at the Wiltshire club. Kevin delighted supporters against Wimbledon and again at Telford.

By the way tonigh's match has to be played to a finish! If necessary there will be 30 minutes extra time, and if the scores are still level, a penalty shoot-out will decide it.

Don't forget, we play Enfield again on Saturday, this time at Southbury Road, and look forward to big support for what will be a truly vital match as Enfield are hard on our heels in the League.



Around the Clubs
