

Introducing Barnet

BARRY FRY (Manager): The longest serving manager in the Alliance Premier (now Gola) League, having been appointed to the post at Underhill in 1979, Barry played for Manchester United, Bolton Wanderers, Luton Town, Gravesend & Northfleet, Orient, Romford and Bedford before turning to management with Dunstable. He was later manager at both Bedford Town and Hillingdon Borough.

PETER BROWN (Midfield): Peter joined Barnet from Tring Town in 1982. He began his career at Chelsea before moving on to play in Wimbledon's first team, generally as a right full-back.

ANDY GOODCHILD (Defender): Another recent signing, teenager defender. Andy was once on Tottenham Hotspur's books.

KEVIN MILLETT (Defender): Signed from Hillingdon Borough for a £2,000 fee in 1979, Kevin has served the Bees well in the APL. He has also played for Bedford Town and Luton Town.

BILL BALDRY (Defender): Following a spell as an amateur with Luton Town, Bill went on to play for Cambridge United, Bedford Town and Bishop's Stortford. He joined Barnet from St. Albans City in 1983.

JOHN MARGERRISON (Midfield): After commencing his career at Tottenham Hotspur, John moved on to gain plenty of Football League experience with Fulham and Orient. He joined Barnet last summer.

EDWIN STEIN (Midfield): The brother of Luton and England striker Brian, Eddie joined Barnet from Dagenham in 1982. He has also played for Edgware and Harrow Borough.

NICKY EVANS (Forward): Nicky partnered Stuart Atkins in Kettering's front line before Atkins moved to Underhill. Nicky joined Barnet in May 1983. His previous clubs include QPR and Peterborough United.

STUART ATKINS (Forward): Barnet paid Kettering Town £3,000 to sign Stuart in March 1982. He has also played for Chesham United and Dunstable.

STEVE MAHONEY (Forward): Barnet's leading goal-scorer last season, Steve joined the Bees from Hitchin Town in 1982. He has also served Stevenage Athletic and Hertford Town.

MIKE PITTAWAY (Defender): A former England Schoolboys international, Mike joined Barnet from Arsenal three years ago. He was a regular member of the Gunners' reserves side in season 1980/81.



ALTRINCHAM: Altrincham have transferred midfielder Phil Derbyshire to Stafford Rangers for a small fee. Derbyshire, a former England Semi-professional international, was formerly with Northern Premier League side Mossley and has been unable to play for Altrincham this season due to work commitments restricting his training.

BARNET: 'Keeper Gary Phillips has been transferred to Brentford for a £5,000 fee. Striker Nicky Evans has turned down a move to Nuneaton Borough after the clubs had agreed a £4,000 fee, and

midfielder John Docker has been transfer-listed at his own request.

BARROW: Barrow moved swiftly following the resignation of player/manager Peter McDonnell and have appointed Brian Kidd in his place. Kidd, who was formerly with Manchester United, Arsenal, Everton, Manchester City and Bolton Wanderers, won two full caps for England and has

recently been playing in the U.S.A.

Joining Kidd at Barrow as assistant manager is John Cooke, who has steered Droylesden to the top of Division Two of the North-West Counties League this season. They will be assisted by former Workington manager Joe Wojciechowicz, who joined the club in the summer as assistant to McDonnell. McDonnell is staying with the club as a player and it is hoped his form will continue to be as good as it has been since he joined the club in July of last year.


